

**Fund Development Committee Report to the Board of Directors

- Letter of request to RDEK for discretionary grant in aid to the Animal Welfare Fund was denied funding
- Animal Welfare Opportunity Fund now ready for endowment. Donations totaling \$575 were received to assist with moving the fund to endowment

- \$4000 needs to be raised to move fund to endowment
